#### **Steps to Setup Shared Configuration**

#### 1. Set Permitted URLs

Any website where a Widget is placed must be included in your "permitted URLs" list. Spermitted URLs.





## **Shadow DOM**

What makes a widget a Web Component



#### **Shadow Root**

- Shadow DOM allows hidden DOM trees to be attached to elements in the regular DOM tree.
- A Shadow DOM can have its own Styles, and Life-Cycle Events outside the parent or HOST DOM.

### Breakpoints

- In some advanced scenarios you might want to further control some styles based on screen sizes
- Widgets is based on 3-4 primary css breakpoints, but all 6 in use are accessible and customizable.
