Purpose

- Church polity
- Formal process
- Not necessarily dependent on activity

Has this person officially joined your church?

- Daily summary of database activity
- Use in conjunction with other tracking fields

Purpose

 Depends on how it is managed... but we have MP best practices for how to do it!



Best Practices

- Keep the list small (5-7 items if possible)
- Make the options broad
- Avoid options that require interpretation (i.e. regular attender)
- Avoid using this field for membership or registration data
- Use in conjunction with contact status and member status to create sub-categories
- Make sure you know your default value (configuration setting)



Best Practices

- Decide your internal protocol on how this field is assigned when contacts are created*:
 - Use *ChangeMe or *Temp Participant Type?
 - Use a *New* or *Guest* type?
 - Make a judgement call on each entry?
- Create a plan for how this field will be managed moving forward

Try to create options that help you answer the question: *How is that person participating in the life of your church?*

Management Tips

- Define your list of participant types in *Lookup Values*
 - Take advantage of the description field make it extra clear
- Setup a view notification for your placeholder participant type (*Temp Participant / *ChangeMe)
 - Consider including a field for who updated it
- Spot-check participant type as you make other changes
